Injury from using tweezers and Cocktail sticks	<b>5</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>5</b>	Children monitored. Told about dangers and how they should use them correctly. Informed not to wave them around.
Infections etc from pellets	<b>5</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>5</b>	Mark ends of cocktail sticks and only hold them on the marked ends. Instructed not to touch pellets/bones but to use equipment to move them. Instructed to keep all items on tray. Wash hands before eat, do not touch face/mouth – warn of dangers. Disinfect owl pellets before dissection.
Ingestion of disinfectant	<b>3</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>3</b>	Marked ends of cocktail sticks and only hold them on the marked ends. Instructed not to touch pellets/bones but to use equipment to move them. Instructed to keep all items on tray. Must wash hands before eat, do not touch face/mouth – warn of dangers. Open windows if needed so that smell of disinfectant does not affect group.
